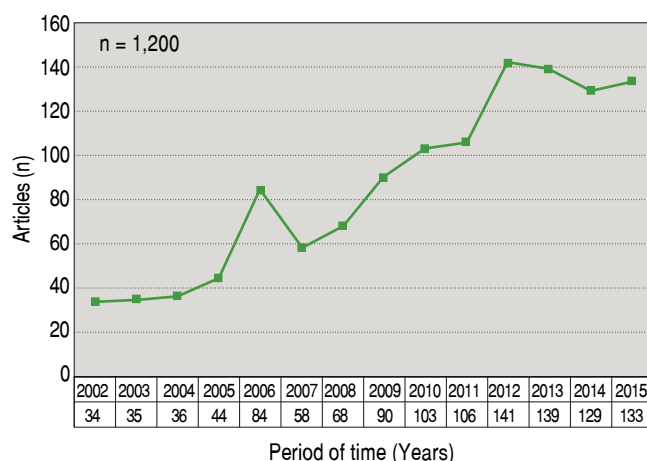


Figure 1. Number of publications per year in *Annals of Hepatology*.
