The changes that should be revised are the followings:

- In Table III page 281, at the second line it appears the text "Age < 10 years"; that should be changed to "Age > 10 years".
- In the last paragraph, in the second line at page 282 the text "...to moulds or age (children)..." should be changed to "...to moulds or age (> 10 years)...".
